Pepco Energy Services, an affiliate of Pepco Holdings, Inc., will hold an Open House to educate residents and other critical stakeholders about plans to demolish the Benning Power Plant in 2014. The Open House will feature exhibits about the demolition procedures, environmental assessments and community impacts of the demolition. Representatives from Pepco Energy Services will answer questions about the process and the timetable.

PURPOSE

The Open House is being held to provide information about the demolition project and will serve as a forum for answering questions from residents.

In 2007, Pepco Energy Services announced plans for closing the Benning Power Plant, which was built in 1906 and operated by Pepco Energy Services since 2000, based on planned upgrades to Pepco's transmission grid that would eliminate the need for electricity generated by the plant.

In June 2012, operations ceased at the plant and the decommissioning process began – cleaning, securing and maintaining the plant – in accordance with District of Columbia and federal environmental regulations. As part of the decommissioning process, the power plant will be demolished, including the cooling towers and smoke stacks. Portions of the plant will be imploded.
